

POINTE COUPEE PARISH PORT



LOCATION – Pointe Coupee Parish, 19255 Port Rd., Lettsworth, LA 70753 (MI 4.6 Lower Red River)

ORGANIZATION – The Pointe Coupee Port, Harbor and Terminal District was created in 1967 by ACT 23 of the Louisiana Legislature. The Port Commission is composed of seven members appointed as follows: 4 commissioners appointed by the Police Jury; 2 commissioners appointed by the City of New Roads; 1 appointed by the Village of Morganza.

Jurisdiction is all territory lying within the boundaries of Pointe Coupee Parish. A dock facility and parish owned industrial park is located near Lettsworth on the Lower Old River channel, which links the Mississippi, Atchafalaya and Red rivers.
