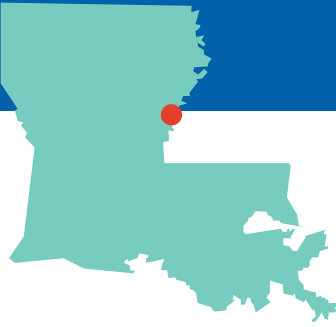


VIDALIA PORT COMMISSION



LOCATION – Located on U.S. Highway 131 (2.5 miles south of the City of Vidalia adjacent to the Vidalia Industrial Park). This is an emerging shallow draft port. There are no structures or improvements present. The port will be part of a 225-acre maritime park.

ORGANIZATION – The Vidalia Port Commission was created by Act No. 10 of the 1981 extraordinary session of the Louisiana Legislature. It is governed by board of commissioners consisting of 5 members who serve for a 2-year term.
