

WEST CAMERON PORT COMMISSION



LOCATION – The Port is located on the U.S. Gulf of Mexico with territorial limits and jurisdiction of all the area comprising Wards 3, 4, 5, and 6 of the Parish of Cameron, Louisiana.

ORGANIZATION – The West Cameron Port Commission was created in 1968 by R.S. 35:2551 with jurisdiction comprised of Wards 3, 4, 5, and 6 of the Parish of Cameron, Louisiana.

The organization is composed of 9 commissioners with 6-year terms and their monthly meetings are scheduled the last Tuesday of every month at 6:30 p.m. with the location varying between different wards in the District.

The powers of the Commission vary. They have the authority to regulate, construct, own, maintain, operate, acquire, expropriate according to the expropriation laws of the State with some restrictions, levy taxes, bonds, and do any and all things necessary or proper for the government regulation, development and control of the business of the District.
